HARD & RIGID PLASTICS

Plastic packaging from consumer goods; DVD cases; rigid plastic containers, like milk jugs and margarine tubs, buckets, bins, etc.



SOFT PLASTICS

Shopping bags, clean storage bags, shrink and bubble wrap, polyethylene foam. Soiled items, tarps, cellophane, biodegradable and foil-lined bags NOT accepted in this category.



STYROFOAM (Polystyrene)

Clean packing blocks from electronics, packing peanuts, insulation (sorted into different categories).



TETRA PAKS (Gable Top Cartons)

Milk, Cream, Soy, Soup, EggBeaters, Rice Milk, Juice, etc.
MUST BE RINSED OR THEY ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

FOIL-LINED BAGS

Chip bags, Candy/Granola Bar wrappers, Bags from Coffee Beans. **MUST BE PRE-RINSED.**



FOAM CUPS & TAKE-OUT CONTAINERS

Clam Shell containers, cups, meat trays, egg cartons, etc.
MUST BE PRE-RINSED.



ELECTRONICS

Monitors, TVs, Telephones, Keyboards, Printers, Copiers, Stereos, CD/DVD Players,, etc.



BATTERIES

All kinds of batteries, by the pound; must be in a ziploc bag.
